In the event I cannot be reached in an EMERGENCY, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the Director of Youth Ministry to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for, and order injection, anesthesia, or surgery for my child as named above.

Behavior Contract

The safety and well-being of all students is a top priority for our Youth Ministry volunteers, staff, and the elders of West Valley Presbyterian Church (WVPC). Accordingly, all youth ministry students and their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must read and sign this contract.

Basic Conduct & Expectations

Each student is expected to abide by all instructions set forth by the Youth Director, Youth Advisors, and chaperones. For example, rules regarding appropriate attire, public displays of affection, time schedule, and common courtesy and respect, will be followed at all times.

Attire Guidelines

- Tops must have a modest neckline, straps at least one-inch thick, and covered midriff
- See-through or lacy blouses must have full coverage underneath
- Dresses or shorts should be longer than your fingertips when your arms are at your side
- No sagging pants (undergarments should not show over your waistband)
- No offensive language or logos
- Swimsuit must be one-piece (no cutouts) for girls and modest trunks or shorts for boys

Technology Guidelines

- Cell phones, game devices and other tech devices are only allowed during travel to and from events
 - ◊ Students are to put away all devices or give them to leaders once they have arrived at their destination
 - ◊ Students who abuse the rules may have their device(s) taken away. The device(s) will then be returned to their parent or legal guardian at pickup

Behavior Requiring Immediate Dismissal

Any behavioral infraction or incident deemed uncontrollable by the Youth Director, advisors, and or adult chaperones will result in a call to the youth's parent(s) or legal guardian(s). The parent or legal guardian will be expected to pick up their youth immediately at the event location at their own expense. Such infractions include, but are not limited to, any illegal activity (use of tobacco, drugs or alcohol, illegal possession of weapons, etc.) or any participation in activities that puts oneself and /or others at an unacceptable level of physical or emotional risk (bullying, hazing, physical violence, sexual activity, "daredevil" type stunts, etc.).
