²³ “Therefore, the kingdom of heaven is like a king who wanted to settle accounts with his servants. ²⁴ As he began to settle accounts, one servant was brought to him. ²⁵ Since he was not able to pay, the master ordered that he and his wife and his children and all the things he had were sold to pay the debt. ²⁶ The servant begged, ‘Be patient with me, and I will pay back everything.’ ²⁷ The servant’s master took pity on him and let him go. ²⁸ After he had gone, the master found one of his fellow servants who owed him a hundred silver coins.^[b] He grabbed him and began to choke him. ²⁹ The fellow servant begged, ‘Be patient with me, and I will pay it back.’ ³⁰ “But he refused. Instead, he went off and had the man thrown into prison until he could pay the debt. ³¹ When the other servants heard this, they were afraid and told their master everything that had happened. ³² “Then the master called the servant in. ‘You wicked servant,’ he said, ‘I forgave you all that debt because you begged me. Why didn’t you have mercy on your fellow servant just as I had on you?’ ³³ In anger his master handed him over to the jailers to be tortured. ³⁴ “This is how my heavenly Father will treat each of you unless you forgive your brother or sister from your heart.”
